## LAKE EDINBORO SPORTSMANS LEAGUE RANGE RULES

- 1. Rifle and handgun ranges are open from 9 a.m., prevailing time, until sunset, unless otherwise posted. The ranges will be closed during organized trap and /or Skeet shooting.
- 2. An individual or an organized group using the range is responsible for keeping the area clean and free of debris, and may not discard, deposit, leave or throw litter except in approved refuse containers. Range users shall remove targets from range backboards when shooting is completed and prior to leaving the range.
- 3. LESL is not responsible for anyone injured on the range. An individual using LESL- owned ranges does so at his own risk and assumes all responsibility for injuries to a person or property caused by or to him.
- 4. When more than one person is using the range, a range officer shall be designated.
- 5. An individual under 16 years of age may not use the range unless accompanied by a person 21 years of age or older.
- 6. The appropriate regional director or designee may close a range by posting signs to that effect. An individual or organized group may not use the range during a period when it is posted as closed.
- 7. ID Code cards may only be used by the member named on the card. Guest are the responsibility of the LESL member
- 8. Only shoot the center bench when shooting at the 25-yard and 50-yard target.

## 9. Prohibited acts at the rifle and handgun range

- a) Discharge a firearm from any location on the range other than an established shooting station on the firing line.
- b) Discharge a firearm at any target other than a paper target placed on a permanent target backboard mounted by the LESL. Users are prohibited from intentionally shooting at or damaging the frames or stands constructed by the LESL to mount permanent target backboards.
- c) Discharge armor piercing, incendiary, explosive, Tannerite, tracer or multiple projectile ammunition.
- d) Be intoxicated, use, or possess an intoxicating beverage or controlled substance on the range.
- e) Discharge an automatic firearm
- f) Shooting 50 caliber centerfire rifles
- g) Refrain from multiple rapid-fire bursts.
- h) Shooting handguns on the rifle range
- 10. Breaking any of these rules will result in the termination of the offenders LESL membership and possible damages. The authorities may be notified if state or local laws were broken.
