

Hobbs Do It Center Open Trap Shoot

Rules and Regulations

1. Registration 4:00 pm – 8:00 pm.
2. 50 bird shoot.
3. All shells factory – 1 1/8 oz. load, 3 dram equivalent or hand-loads, not to exceed this load (max 7-1/2 shot).
4. All shooters will be classed according to Erie/Crawford classification from current year league scores. (To date) at least 4 scores must be produces to be classed. If 4 scores from the current season can not be produces, your pre-season shoot class or any other established average will be used.

All unclassed shooters will be placed in “AA”.

A special “HUNTER CLASS” is provided for those shooters that have never shot organized trap, skeet or sporting clays.

5. \$20 Entry Fee.

Novice, Sub-Junior and Junior (shooters 17 and under) pay \$10 entry fee.

6. Prizes will be given for High Gun (first only).

Plus, first, second and third place in the following classes:

Novice (12 and under)

Sub – Junior (13-14)

Junior (15 – 17)

Hunter (no previous experience with organized trap, skeet or sporting clays)

7. Any shooter qualifying for two classes must choose one and forfeit the right to the second class.
Any shooter qualifying for multiple categories must choose one at registration time.
8. All 1st, 2nd, 3rd, place ties will be decided by reverse run.
High Gun ties will be decided by sudden death shoot off (miss and out).
