The Lake Edinboro Sportsman League Junior trap shooting team excelled at the SCTP National Championships in Marengo, Ohio, securing first place in the 200 target singles trap event. The competition, held July 13-20, featured Lake Edinboro achieving a total team score of 965, outperforming the second-place team by six targets. Sawyer Shallenberger led the team with an impressive score of 199, while James Sherman followed closely with 198. The team's success is attributed to their determination to improve after a less favorable performance at the states. By the Numbers Lake Edinboro finished with a team score of 965, six targets ahead of second place. Sawyer Shallenberger scored 199, James Sherman scored 198 and Kenny Byerly scored 194. Yes, But Despite the victory, the team had previously placed third at state, indicating a performance variance that they worked hard to overcome. The success at nationals showcased their resilience and commitment to improvement. State of Play The team had four weeks of practice leading up to the national competition. Three out of the five shooters are younger, with two seniors providing experience under pressure. What's Next Looking ahead, the team is likely to maintain their focus on skill development and team cohesion as they prepare for future competitions. Continued practice and the nurturing of young talent could lead to further successes. Bottom Line Winning at the national level signifies a major achievement for the Lake Edinboro Junior trap shooting team, reflecting both their dedication and effectiveness in teamwork.
